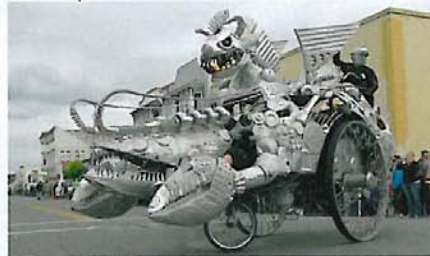
**A Leg Up**
