## Walmart grocery opens in Pleasanton

Walmart has finally opened a Walmart Neighborhood Market store in Pleasanton after controversy and delayed approval by the City Council.

[The Contra Costa Times reports](#) the 33,160-square-foot supermarket on Santa Rita Road is the third in the Bay Area, after locations in San Ramon and San Jose.



A Walmart Neighborhood Market store has open in Pleasanton, the chain's third location in the Bay Area.

Walmart said it hired 85 employees to operate the store.

It replaces a former Nob Hill supermarket, filling a space that has been empty for some time.
